Brombach + Gess delivers glass roof for P&O Cruises' Arvia

P&O Cruises' newest ship Arvia features a Panorama Deck with a retractable glass dome roof produced and installed by Brombach + Gess.

The glass roof - which weighs 156 tonnes and is 43 metres long, 34 metres wide and 62 metres high is made up of one sliding element and two non-moveable parts on either side. The sliding roof allows the deck to be used in all weather conditions and can be opened and closed within just 10 minutes to ensure passengers remain comfortable at all times.



The latest in the European river cruise sector

Almost 90 per cent of European river cruise players found business to be above or in line with their expectations for 2022, according to Seatrade Cruise's first annual *European River Cruise Trends Report*.

Seatrade surveyed stakeholders, such as cruise lines, crewing agencies and port operators, in the European river cruise market in autumn 2022. It also found that:

52% of European river cruise stakeholders predict an increase in the sector by at least 5-10%

62% of stakeholders expect North America to become the biggest source of the market, followed by Continental Europe, UK and Ireland

56% of those surveyed expect hybrid propulsion systems to be the near and mid-term solution for carbon-free operations
